5/6 students have begun their swimming program at Aquanation this term, which consists of one lesson each week on a Friday. Aquanation delivers the Royal Life Saving Society of Australia's 'Swim and Survive' program, which is designed to advance students' confidence, skill level, stroke development, endurance, safety, and enjoyment. This program takes place of the interschool sport program for the 5/6 students in term 3.

Sick Children

A friendly reminder that our school is still bound by COVID safe policies that we are accountable to. This includes the direction that any children with COVID-like symptoms should stay at home. Because of this, if a child presents at school with a runny nose and/or frequent coughing and sneezing you will be called to come and collect them.

Further to this, we have been made aware of extremely high rates of gastro in the community, particularly among younger children. Please remind your children to wash their hands thoroughly at home so they are in the habit of doing this when at school. This practice is especially important considering that hand sanitiser **does not** kill the viruses that cause gastro. If your child becomes ill with gastro-like symptoms, please keep them at home until 48 hours after the last symptoms. Just like COVID, if we all do the right thing we can stop the spread and keep our families healthy.
