After two decades of effective activism, **Whitehorse Friends for Reconciliation (WFFR) are looking for new people of all ages and backgrounds to keep the work going.**

WFFR is a member of ANTaR - Australians for Native Title and Reconciliation, a peak body along with Reconciliation Victoria with whom our members are also connected.

Over the last 2 decades WFFR has conducted, and partnered in many exciting projects, including forums, reconciliation picnics, the 'Short Long Walk in Whitehorse, activity days for local students with First Nations' educators, including making pavers for the Nangnak garden, cultural days for young Aboriginal families, production of an important DVD called 'Nobody's Child', which connected with Aboriginal people who had spent time in children's homes in Whitehorse, family days at the Mullum Mullum Indigenous Gathering Place, and partnering with them on various projects, and many more.

New WFFR members would be expected to participate in developing projects and programs, often in collaboration with the local Aboriginal community, and then helping with the range of tasks needed to successfully carry out these ideas. Of course, people can support this work at their own pace.

Currently we meet monthly – 2nd Thursdays of the month starting in February - at the Koonung Cottage Community House.

We are conducting an information session to help you decide if you would like to join the important reconciliation movement.




